




The competition schedule at the Washington International Horse Show, held in Washington, DC each October, boasts hunter and jumper classes for kids, adult amateurs and professionals. To purchase tickets to WIHS, go to equiery.com and click on "Spectator Events."



Maryland is home to hundreds of breeding farms throughout the state. Although the Thoroughbred is the state's official horse, many breeds are represented in Maryland including Quarter Horses, various Warmbloods, Miniature Horses and Mules.




Maryland's official horse beed is the Thoroughbred. Our state is home to two major Thoroughbred training centers, Fair Hill Training Center in Elkton and the Bowie Training Center in Bowie, as well as three Thoroughbred flat tracks: Pimlico, Laurel and Timoniom. Pimlico Racecourse in Baltimore is home to the Preakness Stakes (G1), the second leg of the Triple Crown as well as the Black-Eyed Susan Stakes (G2) for fillies.



587,000 acres, or nearly 10%, of Maryland land is owned and/or controlled by Maryland horse owners and their families.


188,000 acres are strictly devoted to horses.




The Washington International Horse Show is the country's leading metropolitan indoor equestrian event and is one of the few shows in the country that still offers a Puissance, or High Jump, class. The current WIHS record of 7'7 1/2" is still held by the Thoroughbred Sweet'n' Low and was set in 1983 by rider Anthony D'Ambrosio.



Fair Hill International has been hosting Horse Trials since 1998, based out of the Cecil County Fairgrounds in Fair Hill, MD. FHI is the ONLY place in the world where a rider can begin competing at the introductory level with 18" fences and can move up the levels to compete in a CCI*** and potentially qualify for the Olympics.
